Isaiah 25 Discussion Questions

- 1. In Isaiah 25:1 there are a couple of "I will" statements. It is always good to have a game plan in place before difficulties arise. How will you choose to exalt and praise the Lord when they do come?
- 2. Make a list of some of the wonderful things the Lord has done for you and consider when was the last time you shared that with someone.
 - Prayerfully consider making it a point this week to share the goodness of the Lord with someone.
 Who comes to mind?
- 3. Verses 2 and 3 talk about destruction. Perhaps you have had dreams, plans, etc. come to destruction. What have you learned about trusting the Lord that will help you through the next "tough patch"?
 - What verse(s) has the Lord given you that you can share with your group to help another through their next tough patch?
- 4. Read Jeremiah 29:11 and make a note of how the Lord thinks about you.
 - What does this tell you about the tough times you go through?

- 5. It is because the Lord loves us and wants only good things for us that He makes corrections in our lives. How does knowing this allow you to praise Him during those times when correction is necessary?
- 6. Imagine the beauty of being able to serve the Lord without the pull of sin in your life. What are your thoughts on this?
- 7. Verse 9 boldly declares, "Behold, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us." How do you think making such a bold declaration in speaking to non-believers might help to draw them to the Lord?
 - How can you persevere in waiting for Him in your current circumstances?
 - By what power will this be possible?
- 8. Write down those things you want to praise the Lord for that have happened just this week. Spend some time praising Him for His love, care, and provision for you, and for His promise to never leave you.
