Responding Biblically to Current Cultural Issues

1) How has the Bible shaped your beliefs regarding the following issues?

- Abortion
- Homosexuality
- Sexual intimacy outside of marriage
- Transgenderism

Have you personally experienced pressure to remain quiet about your Biblical beliefs regarding these issues? If so, how did you respond?

2) Why do you think so many in the world see God's laws as designed to take away their freedom?

3) How is God's character reflected in His commandments? Give one example.

4) Psalm 128:1 says, "Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in His ways." What does it mean to "walk in His ways"?

Share a few of the blessings you have experienced from obeying God's commands.

5) Jesus is described as full of grace and truth in John 1:14. How are both these qualities important as we interact with unbelievers?

6) How did Jesus respond with truth and grace to those the religious leaders called "sinners"? Give an example from Scripture.

7) Jesus was often in the company of "sinners." What can believers learn from His example?

Would you like to share the gospel with unbelievers more often than you do? If so, what is preventing you from doing so?

What is one thing the Lord is asking you to do to follow Jesus as He seeks the lost?

8) What are some ways we can help children navigate the complicated social and moral issues of our world?
