

Reflection and Discussion Questions

1. Have you received the baptism with the Holy Spirit? If so, think about how He has changed your life. If you haven't received yet, please ask!
2. Read the outline you were given on the Holy Spirit. If you have any questions, write them down and talk with your discussion leader about them.
3. Which characteristics of the Holy Spirit especially encourage you today? (it is hard to choose!!)
4. Can you think of a few examples from your life concerning *how* you “put off” and “make no provision for the flesh”, desires, tendencies, and impulses?
5. Can you think of a few examples from your life *how* you “put on the Lord Jesus” and *how* you “walk in the Spirit”?
6. Do you remember a time in your walk with the Lord when you especially struggled, maybe a personality conflict with someone, where you surrendered and asked for the Holy Spirit's love to flow through you and you had victory? Were you surprised, excited, thankful... 😊
7. Do you ask the Lord each morning to freshly fill you with His Spirit? How can you become more aware to as for re-fillings during the day?
8. How have you grown in being led by the Spirit during the day? In what ways does He speak to you?
9. What is the Lord speaking to you now about what you need to do to grow in awareness of walking in His Spirit?

These questions are to be used for each of the teachings to help us reflect upon and process with the Lord what we heard and learned. Please be prepared to share what the Lord has shown you with your group.

General Discussion Questions

1. How did the Lord speak to you through the teaching?
2. Did you learn anything new about this topic or see it in a new light?
3. What struggles do you face related to this topic?
4. What is the Lord asking you to do as a result of the teaching?
5. Give an example of how you have grown spiritually related to this topic.
6. How do you guard against the influence of the world regarding this topic?
7. What can we learn from the life of Jesus about this topic?
8. Was there anything you did not understand from the teaching?
9. What Scripture is most helpful to you regarding this topic?
10. What did you learn about the Lord's character from the teaching?
11. How can we pray for you regarding this topic?
12. What encouragement do you have for other women related to the teaching?
