Reflection and Discussion Questions

Therefore, I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men. 1 Timothy 2:1

- 1. When did your prayer life begin and in what ways has it grown?
- 2. Do you have a time and place set aside where you regularly meet with the Lord in prayer? Do you have a routine, prayer list or journal, or a prayer partner that you meet with?
- 3. How does prayer engage your heart, soul, mind and strength?
- 4. What is the effectual, fervent prayer of a righteous man? Why were Elijah's prayers effective?
- 5. Can you describe a prayer request you prayed consistently over a long period of time and how God answered it?
- 6. What has been your experience with people who have interceded for you during the trials of your life? What have you learned from their prayers?
- 7. Make a list of 3 or 4 people you are praying for. By their names write a verse you can pray for them.
- 8. Make another list of 3 or 4 supplications for yourself along with verses you can claim as you pray for these requests.
- 9. How can we pray for our church, our pastors, worship leaders and those in leadership positions here?
- 10. How should we pray for our nation and those in positions of leadership in the government?

These questions are to be used for each of the teachings to help us reflect upon and process with the Lord what we heard and learned. Please be prepared to share what the Lord has shown you with your group.

General Discussion Questions

1. How did the Lord speak to you through the teaching?
2. Did you learn anything new about this topic or see it in a new light?
3. What struggles do you face related to this topic?
4. What is the Lord asking you to do as a result of the teaching?
5. Give an example of how you have grown spiritually related to this topic.

7. What can we learn from the life of Jesus about this topic?
8. Was there anything you did not understand from the teaching?
9. What Scripture is most helpful to you regarding this topic?
10. What did you learn about the Lord's character from the teaching?
11. How can we pray for you regarding this topic?
12. What encouragement do you have for other women related to the teaching?
